FOURTH CHARACTER DESIGNATOR:

"D" = Shipments up to March 2006

With effect from shipments in April 2006,

The fourth character designates the type of PLL used:

"A" = NOVA Receiver

"B" = NPC Receiver with 16.8MHz Crystal

"C" = ALL CRYSTAL Receiver

"E" = Narrowband Receiver

"F" = NPC Receiver with 11.25MHz Crystal

"G" = NPC Receiver with microchip MCU (BR502) (Archive)

"H" = NJRC Receivers

"J" = NJRC Narrowband Receivers

"X" = Not used

FIFTH CHARACTER DESIGNATOR:

The fifth character designates the year the product was shipped from the manufacturing facility but cannot be vowels "I" and "O":

"A" = 2000, "B" = 2001, "C" = 2002, "D" = 2003, "E" = 2004, "F" = 2005, "G" = 2006, "H" = 2007, "J" = 2008, "K" = 2009, "L" = 2010, "M" = 2011, "N" = 2012, "P" = 2013, "Q" = 2014

SIXTH CHARACTER DESIGNATOR:

The sixth character designates the month the product was shipped from the manufacturing facility:
"A or B" = January, "C or D" = February, "E or F" = March, "G or H" = April, "J or K" = May, "L or M" =
June, "N or P" = July, "Q or R" = August, "S or T" = September, "U or V" = October, "W or X" November
and "Y or Z" = December

SEVENTH through TENTH CHARACTER DESIGNATOR:

The last four (4) characters of the serial number are sequential numbers but CANNOT contain "Y", "0", "1", or any vowels ("A", "E", "I", "O", "U").

Serial Number Example: 51PACJ8888

Bravo 501 Pocsag (Product Code "51P") with NOVA receiver (PLL code "A"), Factory Ship Year is 2002 (Year Code "C"), Factory Ship Month is first half month of May (Month Code "J"), unit sequence code (8888).
